To date the company has produced 6 critically acclaimed productions that have toured the UK and internationally attracting a wide diversity of audiences. The company's most recent production, Ten Sorry Tales, was cocommissioned by DanceEast and Sadler's Wells, previewed in December 2019 and will tour nationally in 2023 following this run at Sadler's Wells. Ballo Arthur Pita's preceding production Stepmother Stepfather was nominated for 5 National Dance Critics' Awards.

Arthur Pita has a distinctive, inclusive and pioneering choreographic approach and his work is informed by experience and curiosity of being 'other'. With a company of performers from different cultural backgrounds, abilities and ages, Arthur's work demonstrates his commitment to diversity.
