∞ {Infinite} is Julia Robert and Rudi Cole's first Dance Theatre Meditation in which they guide the audience through a mystical journey. The outside world of the magical dance on stage will merge with your internal awareness. The premise is movement and consciousness, becoming aware of the infinite power that flows to and through us, giving life to all beings.

This is the first production where they explicitly bring together their shamanic powers to fuse with their signature choreographic movement language.

Throughout the years of Julia and Rudi's worldwide ventures into meditation, energetic channeling, yoga, plant medicine, and personal development they tapped into their internal power and felt called to share a work of art that aligns with their mission to raise human consciousness. During their creative career, they strived for a link that bridged their artistic expression with their spiritual path. ∞ {Infinite} is the culmination of their personal holistic approach, sculpturing a new way to experience a dance production, in which the theatre setting becomes a sacred space conducive for internal realisations. ∞ {Infinite} opens a door through which the audience is invited to tap into the infinity we all contain within.

During this Dance Theatre Meditation, you will be receiving energetic transmissions both through words and movement, channeled by Julia and Rudi and embodied by the stunningly fluid dancers. The cosmic tribe on stage was formed through an intensive time in the dance studio as well as sacred rituals in Nature, connecting beyond the physical realm. All group sessions started with a gratitude practice, tapping into the power of our open hearts.

The whole research and final production was, is, and will continue to unfold as a sacred ritual of movement, light, and sound, reminding us of the cosmic dance we are all a part of and the infinite potential of our future becoming.






Artistic Directors of HUMANHOOD Julia Robert and Rudi Cole say:

ABOUT

Merging Modern Physics & Ancient Mysticism to create visceral and immersive productions, HUMANHOOD aims to share extraordinary experiences that transform and connect us all.

Founded in 2016 by Catalan and Birmingham born artists Julia Robert and Rudi Cole, HUMANHOOD's following has since rapidly grown in the UK and international dance scene.

With a commitment to self-growth and artistic expression, HUMANHOOD's work combines Julia and Rudi's choreographic style and exceptional physicality with scientific research into physics and astrophysics, alongside a focus on Eastern mysticism, to explore how these seemingly different worlds can come together to shape our human experiences. These explorations have taken the artists around the world to work with a wide range of multi-disciplinary artists, spiritual practitioners, shamans and indigenous tribes, to stage productions of high levels of artistic intricacy and spiritual resonance, merging energy-shifting sound, light and movement transporting audiences to a place beyond the senses. The company also collaborates with scientists, including the research team of Birmingham University's physics & astrophysics department.



PREVIOUS WORKS

ZERO, HUMANHOOD's first full-length duet performed by Rudi and Julia, was premiered in 2016 at MAC Birmingham and its 15min extract won 1st Prize at Madrid 30' Choreographic Contest. The same extract won the Tanja Liedtke Prize at the Ballet Gesellschaft International Choreographic Contest in Hanover.

TORUS, the company's first group piece, was selected to be presented as part of the UK Dance Showcase, Aerowaves Twenty in 2021, Seoul International Dance Festival and Barcelona's renowned Grec Festival, amongst others. The piece was nominated for best choreography at the Catalan Critics Awards as well as best lighting design by Tom Visser at DansaCat Awards.

ORBIS and SPHERA, two outdoor duets exploring the relationship between human beings and the moon extensively toured in the outdoor circuit world-wide, and were presented as part of the BBC and Sadler's Wells' digital programme Dancing Nation.

Julia and Rudi, aka HUMANHOOD, are currently Associate Artists at Mercat de les Flors.




CREATIVES



Julia Robert
Choreographer/ Co-Artistic Director

Julia danced since her early ages on this planet expressing her innate fluidity and grace. Captivated by the wonders of the Universe she started a physics degree at Universitat de Barcelona. However, she realised this path was not in alignment with her soul's purpose and dived fully into dance, graduating from the London Contemporary Dance School and performing in some of the world's most recognised theatres. Julia has an innate sensibility for beauty and movement energy as well as a powerful imagination creating magnificent universes on stage. She is passionate about accessing the movement of the body as a portal to higher states of consciousness and unity. She also coaches a selected group of visionary women to answer their call and make an impact.



Rudi Cole
Choreographer/ Co-Artistic Director

Coming from a family of artists having an innate sense for rhythm, musicality and sharp eye for movement quality, Rudi has identified dance as his passion from his early years. He graduated from the Northern School of Contemporary Dance and had a prolific career as a professional dancer including performing in the 2012 London Olympic Games.

He is a devoted practitioner of the internal martial arts fusing the energetic power of the body into the movement quality of the company. His child-like curiosity has brought him to research ancient and shamanic practices around the world, expanding the potential of human physicality.



Julia and Rudi founded HUMANHOOD in 2016 with the vision to create a worldwide movement for the expansion of human consciousness. Since the creation of their first duet ZERO, they have established a clear choreographic language expressing a sublime spiritual sensitivity which has brought the interest and following of the dance sector and beyond, including wellbeing and holistic communities. Their award-winning work has been performed at some of the most prestigious venues (Sadler's Wells and Mercat de les Flors) and festivals (Grec and Venice Biennale) in the world.

In 2021, they started delivering transformative movement workshops, including their success The HUMANHOOD Experience, for individuals looking to connect with their body through the power of movement and dance. They believe it is time for everyone to take the real stage, the Earth's grounds in everyday life, and become a light in the future of humanity.


