Multiverse is Julia Robert and Rudi Cole first VR production in which they invite the user to interact with the aliveness of breath, as it moves, morphs and interacts.

This hypnotic full-body VR experience features interactive clouds-like visuals, bone-conducting bodysuits, synchronised breathing and immersive sound-score, ushering the user into a 8 minutes multi-sensory ride.

“One of the things that was essential for us when thinking about creating a VR project, is that the VR would give the opportunity for users to connect deeper with themselves, their imagination and their body.

The virtual scenario is manifested with cloud-like shapes in a black 360 degree background that becomes an all embracing cosmos of stars.

The breath, like a cloud, inherits the shape of a human body, dancing and ever-morphing while interacting with the visitor.
